Open 24 Hours a Day, 7 Days a Week (Closed 11 Holidays)

Daytime Care: 6:00 AM - 6:00 PM | Night Care: 6:00 PM - 6:00 AM

Tuition is due each Friday in advance of the week of care.

After Friday, a \$25 late tuition payment fee applies. All payments are made through Brightwheel.

Weekend daytime care is available on a consistent weekly schedule (same day(s) each week). Schedule changes require two weeks of written notice.

Weekend Combo Packages

For families needing both daytime and overnight care on weekends. Combo rates are flat rates (not age-tiered) and include both day and night care for the specified period.

Important: Per Texas child care licensing requirements, children may not remain in continuous care for 24 hours on a daily basis. A break in care is required each calendar day. Weekend combo families must arrange a brief pickup and drop-off between the daytime and nighttime care periods each day. The Center Director will work with each family to establish a transition schedule that meets licensing requirements and fits the family's needs.

Weekend combo packages are available on a consistent weekly schedule. Families needing weekend nights only (without daytime) should use the standard Night Care rates below.

Night Care Weekly Tuition

24-Hour Combo: Day + Night (see note below)	\$325

Note: 24-hour combo care is for families with rotating or extended shift schedules (e.g., first responders, healthcare workers). Per Texas child care licensing, children may not remain in continuous care for 24 hours on a daily basis. A break in care is required each calendar day.

Night care rates apply to any night of the week, including weekends. There is no separate weekend night rate.

Drop-In Care

Drop-In Care	Daily Rate
Daytime Drop-In (2 years+, space permitting)	\$65 per day
Night Drop-In (space permitting)	\$75 per night

Drop-in care is available only when space permits and only for children who are pre-registered with complete enrollment files on record.

Annual Supply/Activity Fee Proration Schedule

Families enrolling after September 1st pay a prorated supply/activity fee at enrollment. The full \$100 fee is then due each September 1st thereafter.

Discounts

Sibling Discount	10% off each additional child	Sibling currently enrolled, same household
Military Discount	\$10 off weekly tuition per child	Valid military ID, DD-214, or dependent ID
First Responder	\$10 off weekly tuition per child	Valid department/agency ID (police, fire, EMS)
Teacher/Educator	\$10 off weekly tuition per child	Valid school district ID or current pay stub

Discounts may not be combined (one discount per family). Verification must be provided at enrollment and updated annually by September 1st. The sibling discount applies to the lower tuition rate; the child with the highest rate pays full price.

Child Care Subsidies

Benevolent House Academy accepts Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) Child Care Services subsidies. Families receiving subsidized funding must pay any required co-payment by the first of each week. If co-payment is not received by Friday, enrollment may be subject to review.

Payment Method

All tuition and fee payments are made through the Brightwheel app. The Center Director will provide setup instructions and an invitation code during the enrollment process. Parents are expected to download Brightwheel and set up their payment method before the child's first day.

What Is Included in Tuition

Tuition for children enrolled in full-time care includes the following at no additional charge:

- Breakfast, lunch, and afternoon snack (USDA CACFP). Dinner provided for night care.
- Standard brand diapers, wipes, and infant formula (infant and toddler classrooms).
- All curriculum materials, classroom supplies, and learning activities.
- Field trips and special activities (no additional fees).
- Developmentally appropriate, high-quality programming.

Specialty Items: BHA provides standard brand diapers, wipes, and formula. If your child requires a specific brand, hypoallergenic, sensitive skin, or specialty items due to allergies, medical needs, or parent preference, you must provide those items. Tuition will not be reduced for parent-supplied items. All parent-provided items must be labeled with the child's name.

Holiday Closures

BHA is closed on 11 holidays each year. Tuition is still due during holiday weeks, as your payment reserves your child's enrollment spot.

Inclement Weather and Emergency Closures

In the event of severe weather, natural disaster, or other emergency, BHA may close or delay opening. Parents will be notified as early as possible through Brightwheel. Tuition is still due during weather closures. If the Academy is closed for five or more consecutive business days, tuition credits will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

Tuition Policies

- Tuition covers your child's spot regardless of attendance. No reductions for sick days, closures, holidays, or absences.
 - Two weeks of written notice is required for withdrawal. Tuition is due through the notice period.
 - Tuition is due each Friday in advance of the following week of care via Brightwheel.
 - A non-refundable registration fee of \$75 and an annual supply/activity fee of \$100 are due at enrollment.
 - Part-time enrollment is on set schedules only: 3-day (M/W/F) or 2-day (T/Th). Weekend schedules are also set. Changes require two weeks of written notice.
 - Night care enrollment is on consistent weekly schedules. Drop-off begins at 6:00 PM, pickup by 6:00 AM.
 - Returned checks or failed electronic payments are subject to a \$35 fee in addition to the late tuition payment fee.
